

VACCINE CLINICS



November 7th 2021: Muslim Community Center

Ist clinic offering pediatric vaccines; Pediatricians Dr. Shahreen Hussain and Ferjana Khan, RN, as well as PA Shama Shaikh administered pediatric doses at our designated pediatric vaccine tables.

105 vaccines were administered: 75 pediatric doses and 30 adult doses.





November 13th 2021: IMAAM Center

Volunteers provided from the IMAAM Center helped with registration, and others helped translate for Indonesian, Balinese, Urdu, Bangla, and Spanishspeakers.

Approx. 105 doses were administered: 73 adult doses and 32 pediatric doses.





November 14: Islamic Society of Germantown

ISG provided volunteers to assist in Urdu, Bangla, Hindi, Arabic, and Spanish translation.

F&V partnered with Main Street Pharmacy that provided vaccine doses.





Vaccine clinic at ICM partnered with the Maryland Dept. of Health and MD National Guard Vaccine Equity Task Force to help with registration and administer vaccines.

F&V administered pediatric doses provided by Main Street Pharmacy. Adult doses were arranged and administered by the MD Dept. of Health.











November 2021: Epworth United Methodist Church

Physician and epidemiologist Dr. Anam Tariq addressed questions individuals had about mixing mRNA COVID-19 vaccine manufacturers (i.e. mixing Moderna first and second doses and Pfizer boosters).

A Spanish-speaking community member came to receive his first dose of Moderna, but only Pfizer vaccines were available. Unfortunately he had received misinformation about Pfizer; however, after educating him on the safety of Pfizer, he received his first dose.



Since fully vaccinating her family, Ms. "A" has been advocating for the vaccine in the west African community. She enlisted as a community canvasser with Faith & Vaccines.



Mr. "K" an Afghan refugee brought his two sons to Al Huda school for covid-19 vaccines but was not vaccinated himself and still hesitant. After engaging in discussion, Mr. "K" agreed to get the vaccine.
