






Northwest Portland Area Indian Health Board

- In 1972, Northwest Tribes organized NPAIHB to represent Portland Area Tribes to serve as a liaison and advocate
 Tribal issues and concerns with IHS resources and program services
- NPAIHB is a Public Law 93 -638 Tribal organization that advocates on health care issues for the forty -three federally -recognized Tribes in the states of Idaho, Oregon, and Washington
- Each member tribe appoints a delegate to serve on the NPAIHB through tribal resolution or letter from Tribal Chair






Stafford Act

- The Sandy Recovery Improvement Act (SRIA)
- Assistance is administered exclusively through the Federal Emergency
 Management Act (FEMA)
- Declarations can be made at the request of a Tribal leader
- Reflect Tribal Governments' Status as Sovereign Entities
- Promotes Tribal Self -Determination


