Accessibility

- Lack of genomics providers
- Barriers for non-genomics providers to order testing
 - Lack of confidence/knowledge
 - Limited guidelines in primary care resources
 - Payor requirements (some require genomics providers to place orders or take pedigree)

Equity/Sustainability

- Equitable reimbursement of testing across payors
 - Unclear/inconsistent criteria for coverage

Evolution of evidence

- Guidelines utilized in many aspects of healthcare
- Current format for guidelines unable to match medical knowledge

Strategies for implementation

- Remove barriers (requirements for test ordering)
- Ways to create guidelines to keep up with speed of science
- Should primary care clinicians working in the genomics space create the guidelines for PCPs?
