

Unlocking Intellectual Converty




Overly restrictive licensing and unrealistic expectations can deter innovation or improvement by controlling the exchange of information and materials for research or the ability to improve the patented product.

- FasterCures convened a small IP expert panel to develop a set of guiding principles and points to consider that can serve as a useful tool for all parties in biomedical research, in particular nonprofit disease groups and philanthropists negotiating IP with academic, industrial, and other nonprofit partners.
- The principles are intended to provide guidance for organizations new to IP negotiation as well as to serve as a set of useful values for more experienced organizations.


