Sites and Populations

University Park (UP)

- Undergraduate Population = 39,503
 - 46.2% Female, 53.8% Male
- Graduate/Professional Population = 6,528
 - 45.6% Female, 54.4% Male

Hershey Medical

- Population = 889
 - 52.5% Female, 47.5% Male



Samples and Response Rates

University Park (UP)

- Undergraduate Sample = 11,023
 - Responses = 2,945
 - **Response Rate = 26.7%**
- Graduate/Professional Sample = 4,000
 - Responses = 1,637
 - Response Rate = 40.9%

Hershey Medical

- Census = 889
 - Responses = 411
 - Response Rate = 46.2%


- Penn State administered the original ARC3 19 item scales for both faculty/staff and student harassment
- Data presented here reflects the 16 and 12 item scales
- Therefore, overall numbers may vary slightly from other reports available on Penn State data

Reliability of Subscales (Alphas)

- Faculty/Staff Harassment
 - Overall = .897
 - Gender Harassment-Sexist Hostility = .848
 - Gender Harassment-Crude Behavior = .837
 - Unwanted Sexual Attention = .884
 - Sexual Coercion = .937
- Student Harassment
 - Overall = .923
 - Gender Harassment-Sexist Hostility = .880
 - Gender Harassment-Crude Behavior = .896
 - Unwanted Sexual Attention = N/A
 - Sexual Harassment Via Electronic Communication = .674

As with undergraduate, white graduate/professional students also report higher incident rates compared to non-white students. This pattern is present for both men and women among graduate/professional students.

Among medical students, the same pattern for race appears with white students reporting higher rates of faculty/staff harassment than non-white students. (USA for men appears is the only notable exception)

Mirror patterns seen in frequencies, therefore not presented in detail here.

Faculty/Staff Follow-up Items

Consistent with the previous data, most students indicated that the incident that had the greatest impact on them involved offensive language, gestures, or pictures.

Men were consistently less likely to report the incident involved unwanted sexual attention, touching, or bribes.

Response patterns suggest options were not exhaustive for students experiences.



Crosstabulations between Faculty/Staff and Student Harassment

As expected based on frequencies presented throughout, the highest rates of co-incidence were between Faculty/Staff GH-SH and Student GH-SH.

Rates of co-incidence decrease through the remaining subscales.
