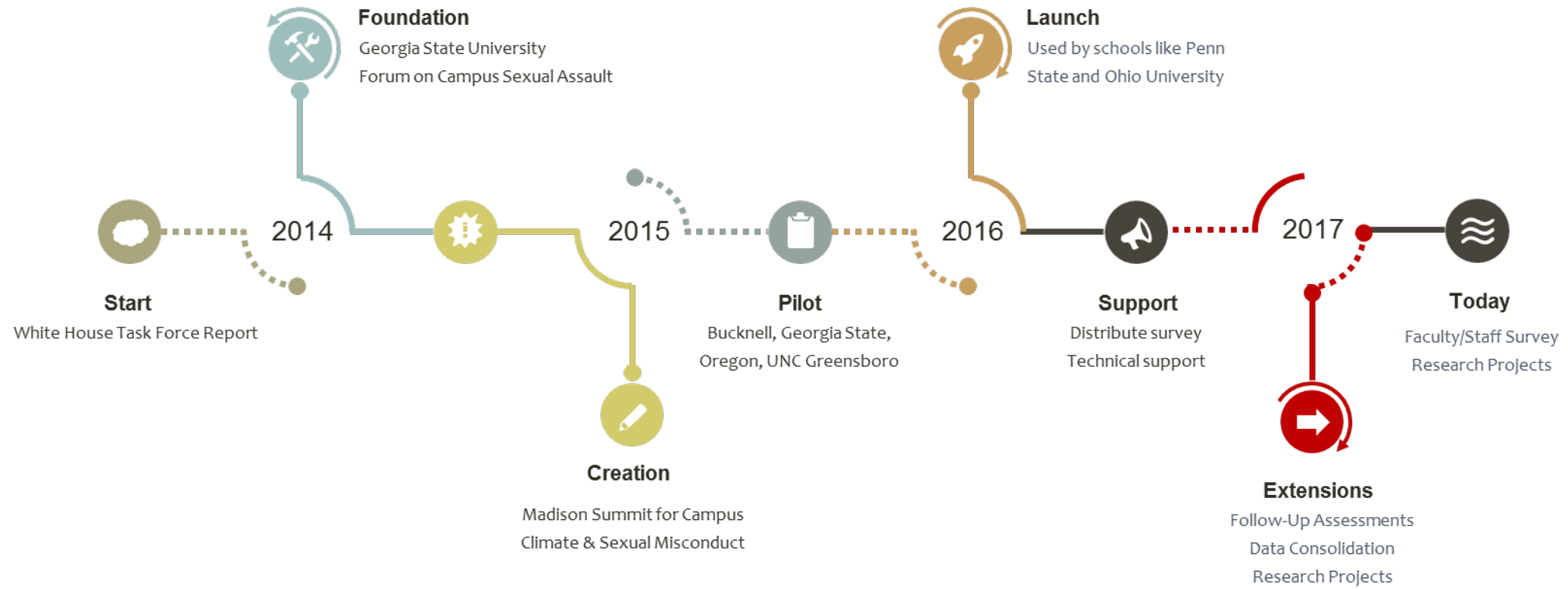

GUIDING PRINCIPLES



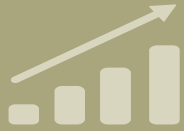
- A commitment to use of the best scientific evidence as the foundation of the survey
