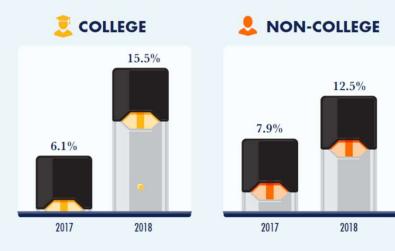

PAST MONTH MARIJUANA VAPING DOUBLES AMONG COLLEGE STUDENTS



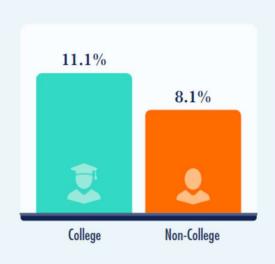

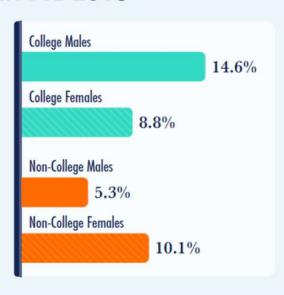
