

History of The Department of the Interior

In 1789 Congress created three Executive Departments:
Foreign Affairs (later in the same year renamed State),
Treasury, and War. It also provided for an Attorney General and
a Postmaster General. Domestic matters were apportioned by
Congress among these departments.
