Grey-Green Spectrum




A Watershed Network Approach

Recent Federal Initiatives to Incorporate Equity

- Justice 40 (2022) Requires federal agencies to deliver 40% of benefits of their investments to underserved communities.
 - CEQ's Climate Economic and Justice Screening Tool
- Circular A-4 (2023) calls for accounting of distributional impacts within BCA for administrative rulemaking (1.4 weighing factor)
- Circular A-94 (2023) calls for a lower discount factor of 3.1% (from 7%) in calculations of future benefits
