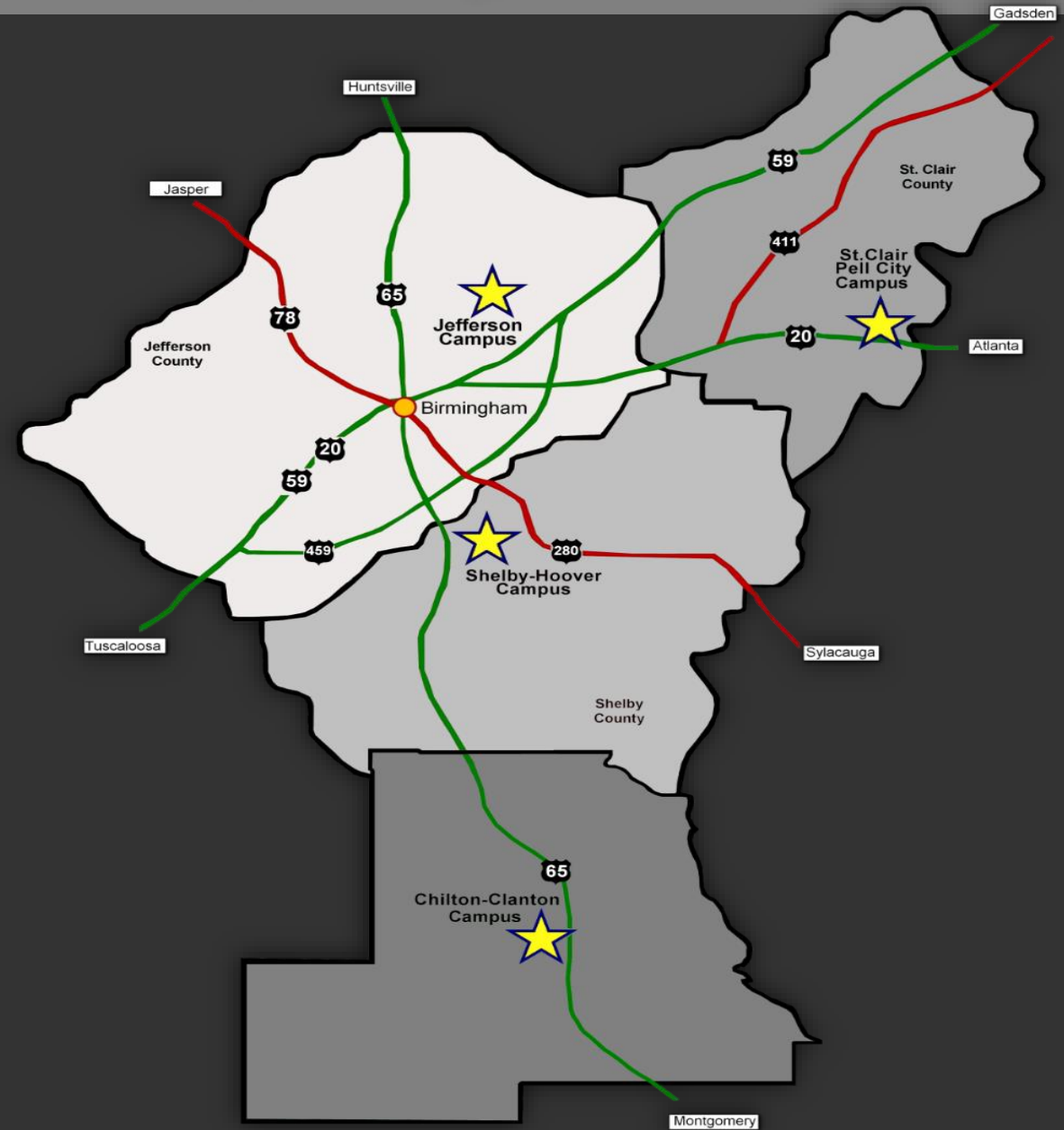


Footprint in Four Counties-Jefferson, Shelby, St. Clair, Chilton
