





\$1.9 National Emergency Dislocated Worker Grant

Kansas: 29 certified active TAA petitions, for 9,675 covered individuals

Wichita Region: 15 petitions for 8,328 covered individuals

26,653 individuals reached through Rapid Response

3,300 Laid-Off workers have received Career Services

545 WIOA Dislocated Workers

541 Trade Impacted Workers
