



Ensuring the Integrity of Federally-Funded Research:

- Conflicts of interest/commitment
- Confidentiality of merit review process
- Protection of pre-publication data



Key Points of the Report of the Senate Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs

- America built a successful research enterprise on certain **values**: reciprocity, integrity, merit-based competition, and transparency.
- Some countries seek to **exploit America's openness** to advance their own national interests. The **most aggressive** has been **China**.
- China does this through talent recruitment programs.
- The federal government's **grant-making agencies** have done little to prevent this from happening, and the **FBI** and other federal agencies have not developed a coordinated response to mitigate the threat.
- These failures continue to undermine the integrity of the American research enterprise and endanger our national security.



NSF Actions to Ensure the Integrity of Federally-Funded Research

- Improved transparency/clarification for disclosure
- Standardization of U.S. citizenship requirements and foreign government talent recruitment program participation restrictions for the NSF workforce
- Risk assessment and analysis through JASON independent advisory group
- Communication and awareness with the scientific community
- Coordination with USG interagency partners



NSF Actions to Improve Transparency / Clarification for Disclosure

- ALL sources of support with a time commitment need to be disclosed
- Both monetary and in-kind support need to be disclosed
- Research support both to the individual and to the institution need to be disclosed
- The research institution determines and resolves potential conflicts of interest
 - Unresolvable conflicts of interest are disclosed to NSF
 - NSF determines capacity and overlap
