



1. 




### Is it possible to test the following proposals?

- 2. Develop Citizen science projects specifically oriented to counter disinformation. For example:

- b) "How disinformation on lightning during a severe storm can affect our health and the electronic systems".



### Idea for countering disinformation in social media in a complex contest:



# Change in Northern Hemisphere ambient temperature in the last millennium\*


Temperature change Northern the Hemisphere, with respect to a value of about 14 °C. See the significant change in the slope around 1900 decade, from a negative trend of -0.02 °C per decade to a positive one of 0.57 °C per decade.


### Cycles in the past world temperature and CO2 concentration

Cycles in global temperature and CO2 concentration, oscillating in coincidence in the last 800 000 years, up to several decades ago.




### Cycles in the past world temperature and CO2 concentration


**Cycles in global** temperature and CO<sub>2</sub> concentration, oscillating in coincidence in the last 800 000 years, up to several decades ago, but after this long period of 800 000 years, a significant increase in both variables were scientifically confirmed.
