AVIATION STRATEGY

*Wheelchairs can cost thousands of pounds and are often customised to the specific needs of the person using them. Wheelchairs can be damaged in transit, whether through incorrect stowage, poor handling or a lack of standardised tether points for safe stowage in the hold. **Damaged wheelchairs directly impact on the quality of life of their users, as well as creating a significant, unplanned, financial cost.***
