

Authorities:

- General authority for maritime enforcement of U.S. Laws
- Search and Rescue
- Prevention of damage, destruction or loss of property within navigable waters
- Traffic management and navigation safety including aids to navigation and anchorage enforcement
- Oversight of facilities
- Safety and Security Zone Enforcement
- Surveillance of ocean dumping
- Lightering zone operations
