- The Coalition for Trust in Health & Science’s (CTHS) was formed in response to growing distrust and false information.
- CTHS's vision is that all people make personally appropriate health decisions for themselves, their families, and communities, based on information that is accurate, understandable, and evidence-based. We are building this future by leading a broad coalition of diverse members – spanning health and science – aligned to promote trust and challenge false information through collaboration, collective learning, and timely, evidence-based resources.
