

Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry

- Non-regulatory federal public health agency
- **Mission:** ATSDR protects communities from harmful health effects related to exposure to natural and man-made hazardous substances.
- We do this by:
 - Responding to environmental health emergencies;
 - Investigating emerging environmental health threats;
 - Conducting research on the health impacts of hazardous waste sites; and
 - Building capabilities of and providing actionable guidance to state and local health partners.
- Regional offices provide national presence

CDC's National Center for Environmental Health - Division of Laboratory Sciences

- Develops laboratory methods to diagnose or assess risk of disease
- Tests for exposure to harmful chemicals
- Helps other labs improve their tests
- Responds to public health emergencies
