

The Mission of Title V is to improve the health and well-being of the nation's mothers, infants, children and youth, including those with special health care needs, and their families.



Title V: Maternal and Child Health Services

Block Grant to States

- **Supports Federal/State partnerships**

- Addresses unique needs of maternal and child health populations in all 59 states/jurisdictions; driven by state needs and priorities
- Requires state match and maintenance of effort

Priority: Reducing tobacco use to lower infant mortality and morbidity

82% decrease in women who smoked during pregnancy

Arizona



Priority: Reducing infant mortality and health disparities

150% increase in children breastfed exclusively for 6 months

Oklahoma



Priority: Improving system of care for children and youth with special health care needs

98% increase in adolescents with special health needs connected to adult health care

Georgia



In 2023, the Title V MCH Services Block Grant helped provide services for an estimated 59 million people.







Title V Performance Measure Framework




Evaluation Logic Model


