Estimated Savings Associated with Supportive Care

Supportive Care Reduces Emergency Department visits 25%

The Oncology Care Model (OCM):

- Reduced the likelihood of an ED visit resulting in an inpatient stay.
- Reduced repeat hospital readmissions.
- Reduced hospital admissions at end of life.
