## Standardization "system" in the U.S.



- Voluntary, decentralized and market-driven
- Led by private sector
- Public-private partnership
  - Differs from centralized standards systems in other countries
- Reflects U.S. culture and public-private sector dynamics
- Relies on cooperation, communication and parity among diverse stakeholder

#### The intersection of Patents and Standards



#### Almost exclusively in high technology standardization

- Standards development volunteer participants offer patented technology to be incorporated into a documentary standard.
- If patented technology is incorporated into the standard and essential for conformity with the standard, then the patent may a Standards Essential Patent (SEP).
- Established standards development organizations have SEP policies generally requiring disclosure for patented technology when contributing that technology to the standards development process and RAND licensing for SEPs.

### China 2035



- launched on March 1, 2018
- developed by Standardization Administration of China (SAC)
- research standardization strategies to inform China's strategy
- focused on Chinese national standards for priority areas
- increase Chinese private sector standards development
- increase Chinese participation and leadership in international standards
