ADVERSE INFORMATION REPORT

Adverse information is "any information that adversely reflects on the integrity or character of a cleared employee, which suggests that his/her ability to safeguard classified information may be impaired, or that his/her access to classified information clearly may not be in the interests of national security." (Industrial Security Letter (ISL) 2011-04). DoD and ODNI policy (32 CFR 117.8(c)1; NISPOM 1-302a and SEAD 3) requires that any information or event that may affect your existing eligibility status and prove prudent in continuous evaluation monitoring must be reported to the appropriate government agency for reevaluation. Continuous evaluation monitoring is based on the13 adjudicative criteria which include: **allegiance to the Unites States, foreign influence, foreign preference, sexual behavior, personal conduct, financial considerations, alcohol consumption, drug involvement, psychological conditions, criminal conduct, security violations, outside activities, and misuse of information technology systems**. Any event related to one of the adjudicative criteria that may have changed adversely since your last background investigation should be reported as soon as possible after the occurrence to the FSO.
