Canal Zone Biological Area

The Canal Zone Biological Area (CZBA) was a research facility on Barro Colorado Island in Panama that studied tropical biology and the flora and fauna of tropical America. The CZBA was originally established by Congress in 1923 as the Barro Colorado Island Laboratory and was created to administer Barro Colorado Island in Gatun Lake, Panama and other tropical areas which may be designated as permanent primeval sites for biological and other research. Board members came from the National Academy of Sciences, Smithsonian Institution, U.S. Secretaries of War, Interior, and Agriculture, Harvard University, and the U.S. National Museum. In 1946, administration was transferred to the Smithsonian Institution and renamed the Smithsonian Tropical Research Institute (STRI).
