Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory ("LBNL") Commitment Statement in support of the National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine (NASEM) Action Collaborative on Preventing Sexual Harassment in Higher Education

The National Academies Report on Sexual Harassment of Women: Climate, Culture, and Consequences in Academic Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine (2018), detailed how comprehensive system-wide reform is urgently needed to foster more welcoming climates for women in our academic pipelines. The report also analyzed and explained how sexual harassment undermines professional and educational attainment of workers and negatively impacts mental and physical health of people of all genders.
