










## Housing Instability & Homelessness: System Failures

N=27,725

- 30% reported experiencing homelessness
- 26% of those who experienced homelessness avoided staying in a shelter because they feared mistreatment as a trans person.
- 70% of those who did stay in a shelter reported some form of mistreatment, including being harassed, sexually or physically assaulted, or kicked out because of being transgender


### Housing Instability & Homelessness:
