






Risk-network structure in Colorado Springs in 1980s


BHOC Activities based on stakeholder input




What should I ask for to make sure I'm getting the most complete STD test?


The answer to this question depends on the kind of sex you're having. A doctor will usually test you for HIV, do a blood test for syphilis, and a urine test for STDs in your genitals. If you have oral sex, you should make sure your doctor swabs your mouth to check for STDs there, and if you bottom, you should make sure they swab your butt too.







National home testing program

- ✓ Apps can reach users who haven't tested recently
- ✓77% of users want apps to make free home test kits available
- ✓ Already exists in Virginia, Arizona, and New York City, successfully reaching those who hadn't tested recently
- √ HIV home test programs pilot begins in March
- ✓ Grindr supporting, others interested
- ✓ Collaborating with NASTAD and Emory
- ✓ HIV now, STDs to follow



SYPHILIS SCARE IS AN ANTI-GAY LIE!


Four cases are NOT an outbreak

Willie Brown's health department is corrupt, out of control, and on a relentless crusade to demonize gay male sex as diseased and deadly!

In July 29, 1999 the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) argeted San Francisco's gay community with an official syphilis alert after four guys who cruise AGL chat rooms allegedly caught the bug, ast week, the DPH upgraded the four-case alert to a "serious syphilis authreak" by placing an alarmist full-page ad in the gay press.

What the DPH failed to inform the public is that all sexually transmitted liseases, including syphilis, are at their lowest rates since the 1950s, iarly syphilis cases have fluctuated between zero and eleven cases per nonth for over two years. The truth is that four monthly cases of yphilis are statistically insignificant in a city with 800,000 residents, our cases are nothing new, do not constitute an outbreak and do not rarrant the drastic measure of a DPH alert aimed at all gay men.

his alert is the latest in a barrage of OPH terror messages intended to ontrol gay sexual behavior. Broadcast through the media, this type of sar campaign is an unwelcome intrusion into our personal say lives that



Figure out how many people notify their partners without help.


