Alaska: Abortion is legal in Alaska. There is no limit on abortion in Alaska based on how far along in pregnancy you are. No parental consent

Montana: Abortion is legal in Montana, however abortion is restricted. Right now, abortion is legal in Montana until “viability,” which is when a fetus has developed enough that it is able to survive outside the uterus with medical help. It usually happens around 24-26 weeks. Parental consent required.

Idaho: Abortion is banned in Idaho with very limited exceptions because of an Idaho law that went into effect August 25, 2022. Gag order in place. Physicians can't refer patients for abortion and our faculty in ID can't teach about abortion. 2023 Trafficking law to prevent minors from getting an abortion with out parental consent, even in cases of incest, even if the adult helping the minor live out of state. 2-5 years of prison time if convicted. 7/2023 in the face of rising maternal mortality the state Maternal Mortality Review Committee was terminated. Only state in the country without one.
