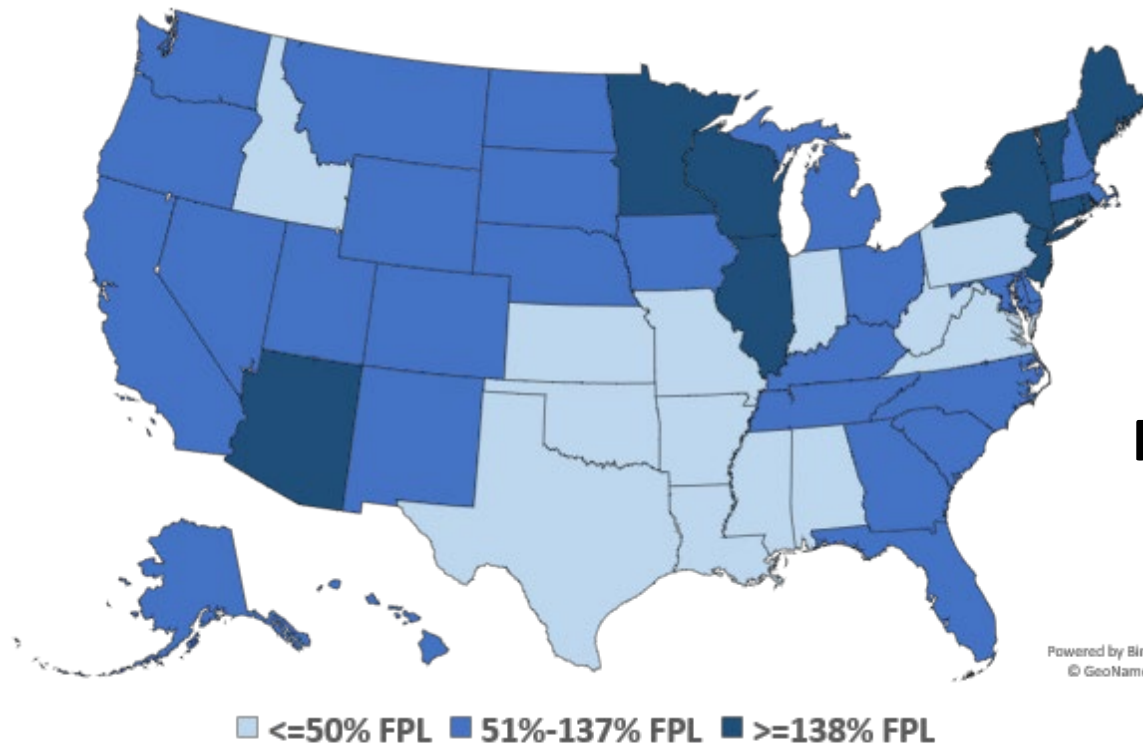

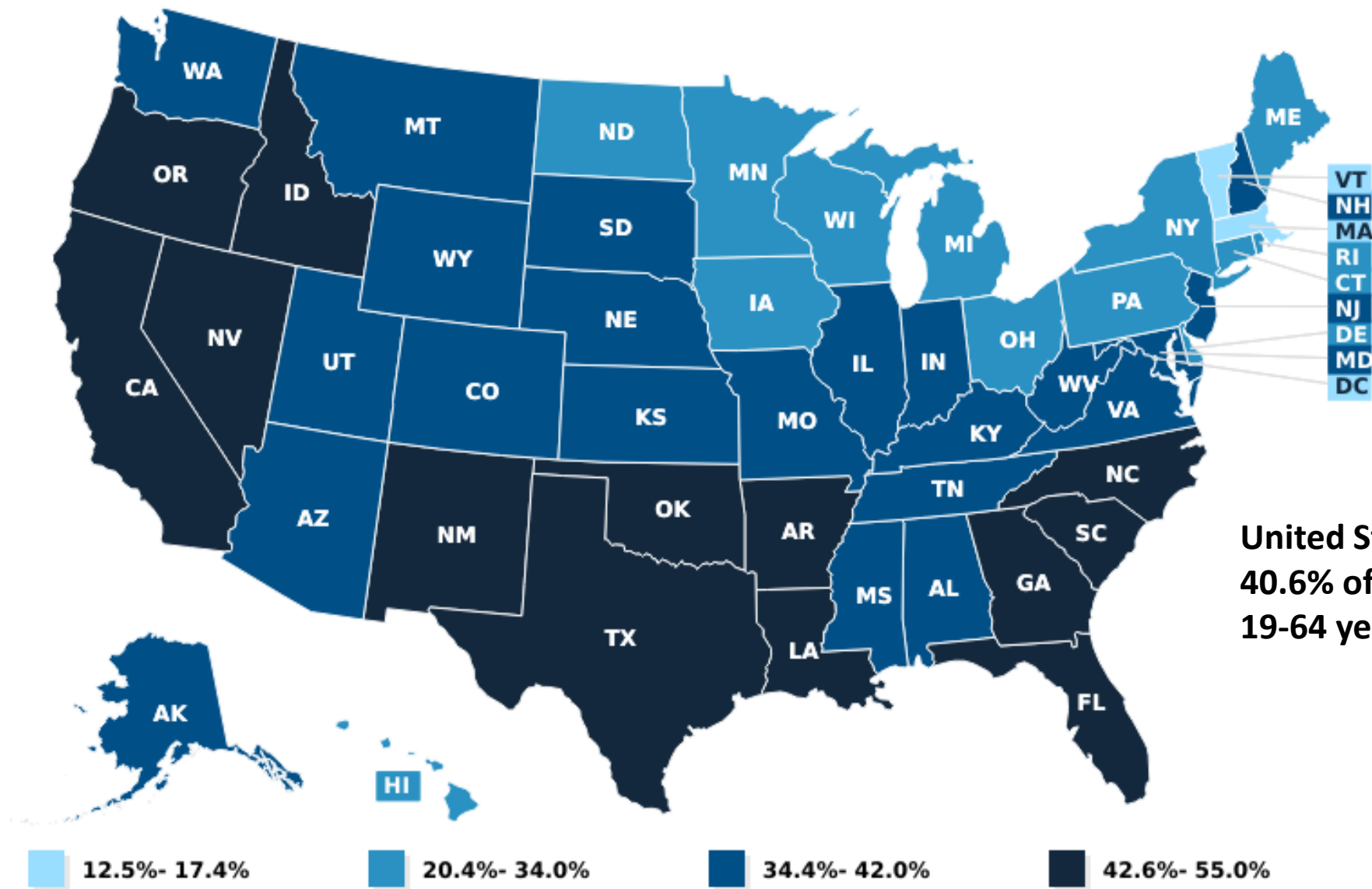
Median Income Eligibility in the United States: 64%

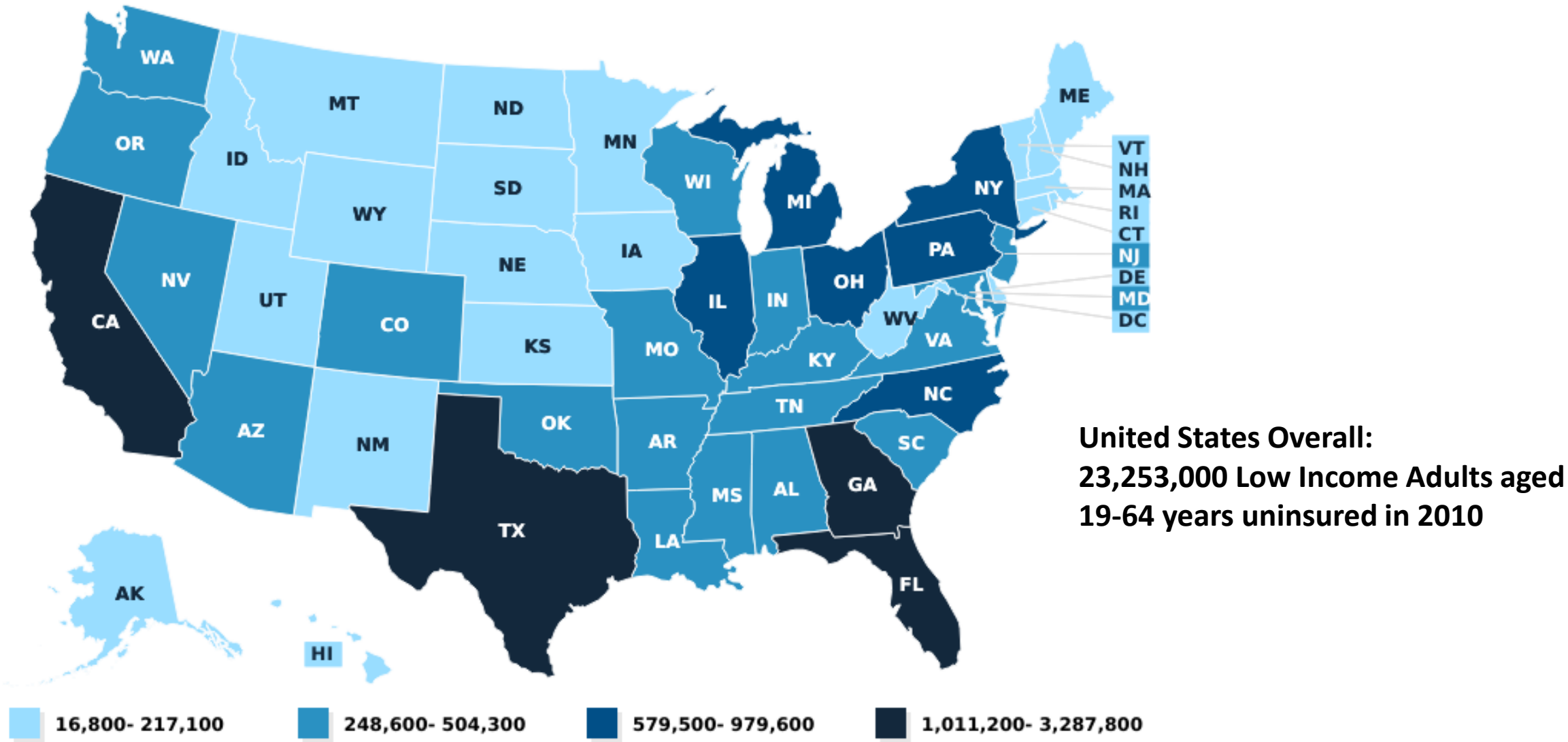
Health Insurance Coverage of Low Income Adults 19-64 (under 200% FPL): Uninsured, 2010

19-64 years uninsured in 2010**

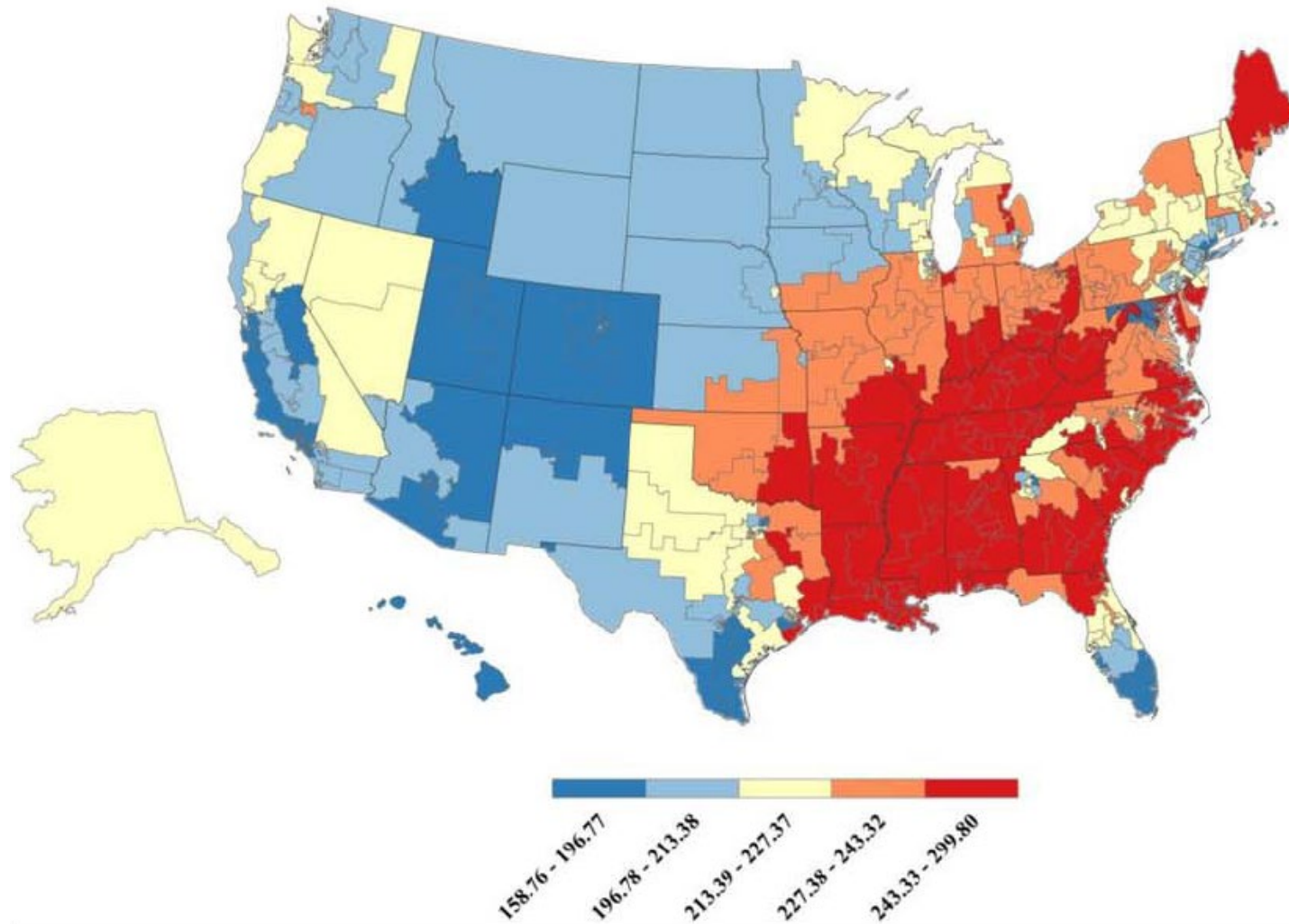
