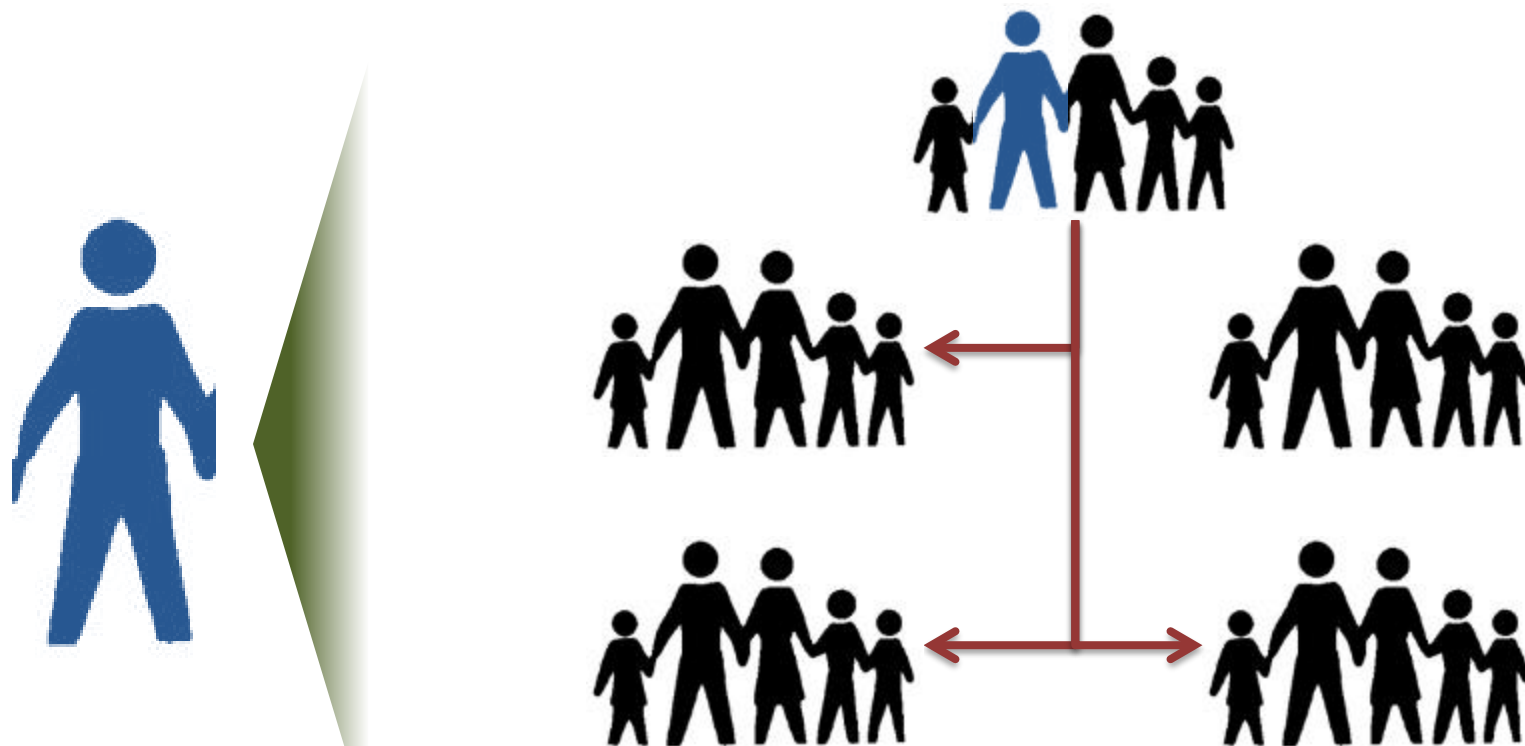

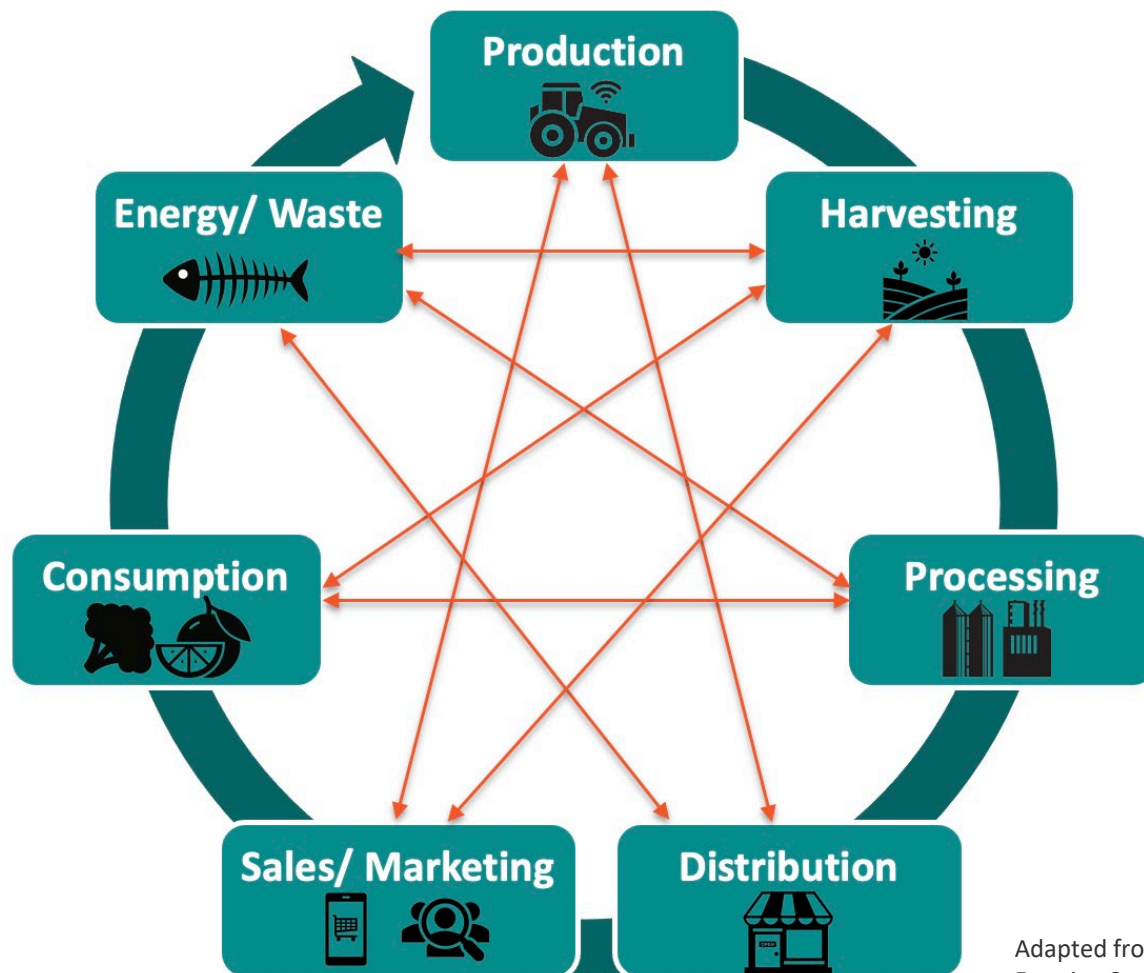


What is a system?

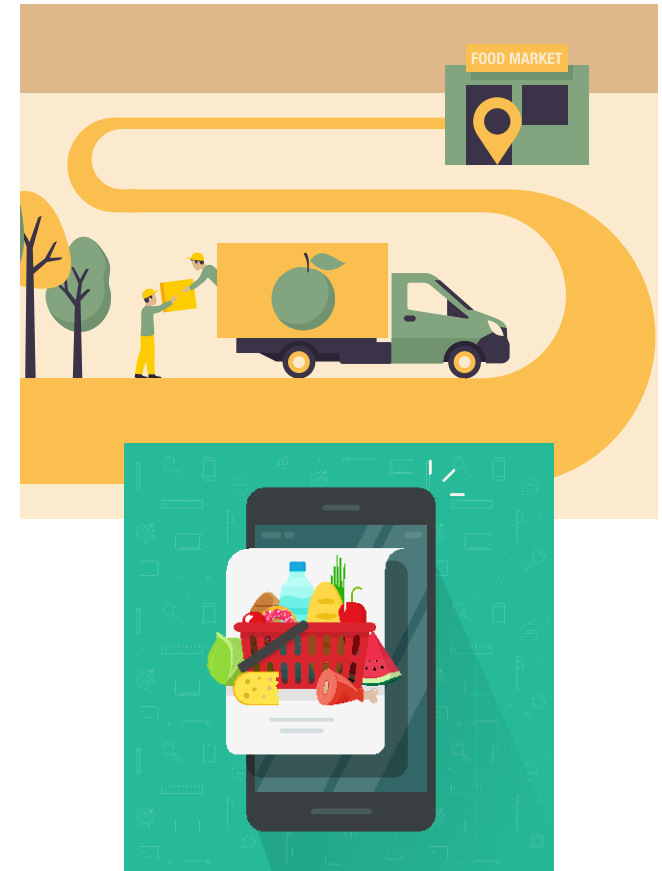
