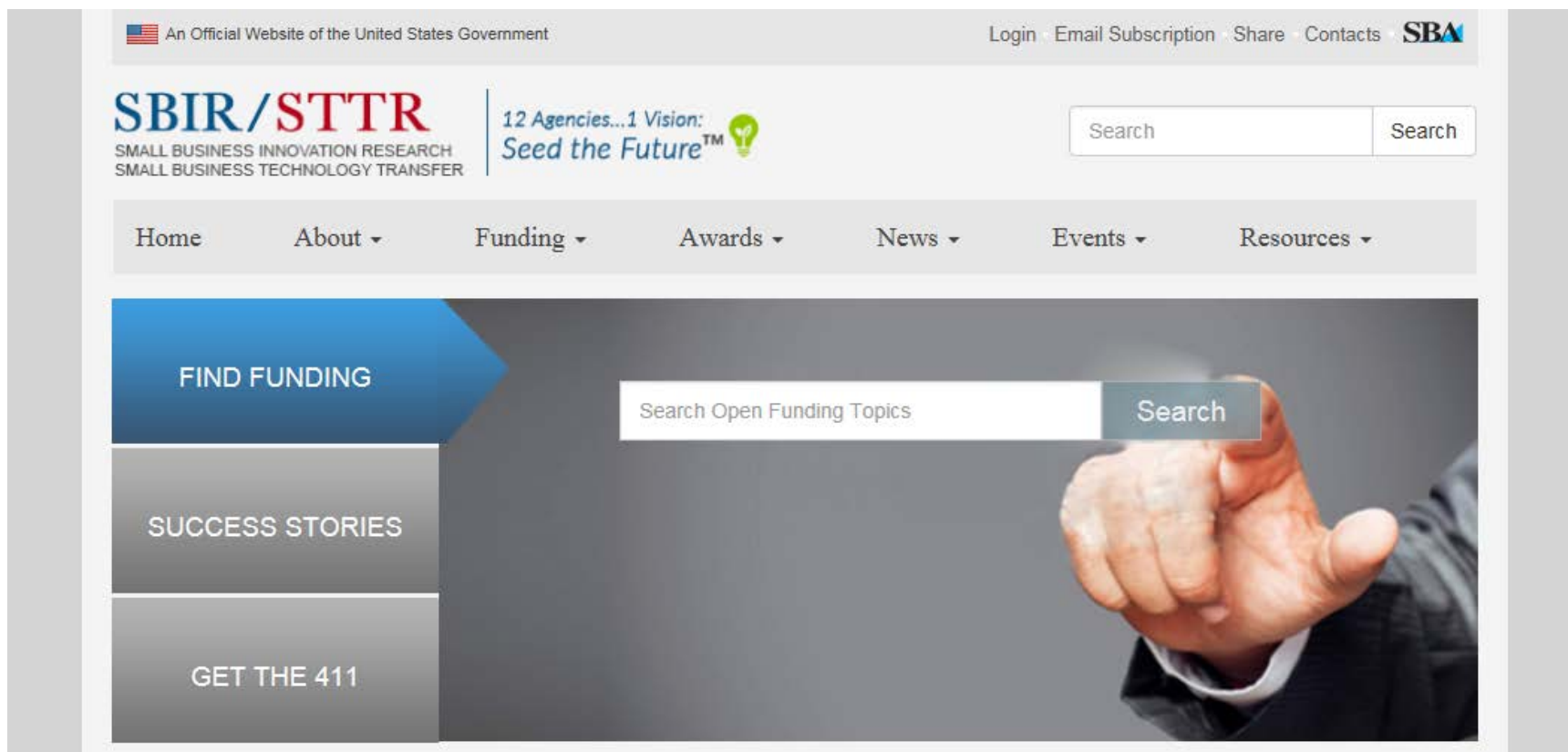

Other Critical Data SBA is or Will Soon be Collecting

- ▶ Commercialization (Phase III Data)
 - ▶ SBA is now requiring firms to submit Phase III funding, employee growth and patent data
 - ▶ Will use this tool to study program impact
- ▶ Will soon gather more detailed data on proposal submissions
- ▶ With new data sources SBA will be better able to study and report on the impact of unique activities (i.e. Road Tour, specific agency commercialization projects, etc.) across Agencies, the country and specific communities
