#### **Assertive Community Treatment**

• 1:14 staff ratio, bachelor's level case manager helps person with basic needs. People also participate in group therapy, psychosocial rehabilitation, and psychiatry.

#### Intensive Case Management

• 1:30 staff ratio, bachelor's level case manager helps person with basic needs. People also participate in group therapy, psychosocial rehabilitation, and psychiatry.

#### **Enhanced Outpatient**

• 1:40 staff ratio. Masters' level therapist is paired with bachelor's level case manager. People also receive psychiatry services.

#### Outpatient

• 1:80 staff ratio, licensed clinician and psychiatrist.

#### Psychiatry-Only

• 1:250 care manager for paperwork; services limited to psychiatry.
