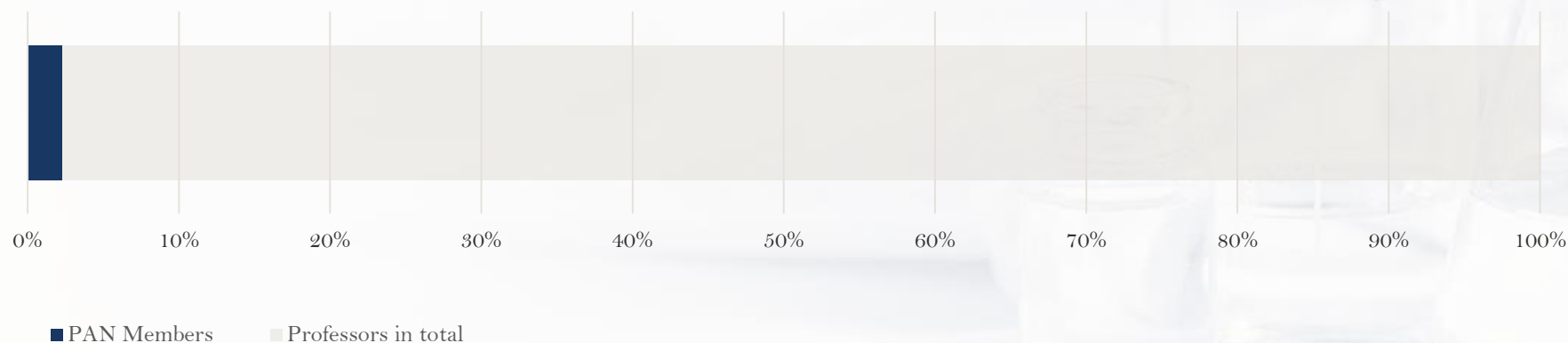

# Basic facts and figures

- The war inflicted by the Russian Federation started on **24 Feb. 2022**
- **3.2 million** Ukrainian refugees came to Poland (May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022)
- In 2 months, the population of Rzeszów increased by **56%**, Gdańsk by 34%, Wrocław by 29%, Warsaw by 15%
- It is estimated that about **6 thousand** Ukrainian scholars are in Poland now

# PAS response to the war in Ukraine



Amendment to the agreement with the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine signed on **March 1st 2022**. Our activities are consulted with the President of the NASU, Prof. Anatoly Zagorodny.

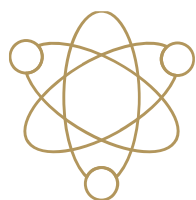


Fellowship program for Ukrainian scholars launched on March 1st, 2022. Ukrainian **grantees at PAS keep their Ukrainian affiliation.**



Our resources **run out in 5 days**. We offered 3-month stipends to **63 Ukrainian scholars**. Our budget from March to June 2022: **1 080 000 PLN**

# International Academic Cooperation in Support of Ukraine



Our partner Academies around the world and international organisations, of which we are a member, provided **support to UA scholars through the PAS.**



**The generous support was provided by** (as of today):

The U.S. National Academy of Sciences (615 000 USD), Academia Sinica and National Cheng Kung Univ. from Taiwan (400 000 USD), Leopoldina (100 000 EUR), Elsevier (250 000 EUR), the Royal Society (TBA) and many others (350 000 PLN).



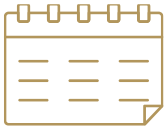
A 6-month stay of one scholar in our Institute costs about 7 700 USD.



# PAS and U.S. NAS for Ukraine



So far, the generous support of the U.S. NAS enabled us to give stipends to **additional 117 scholars** from Ukraine.



Some of them will be provided with longer-term support

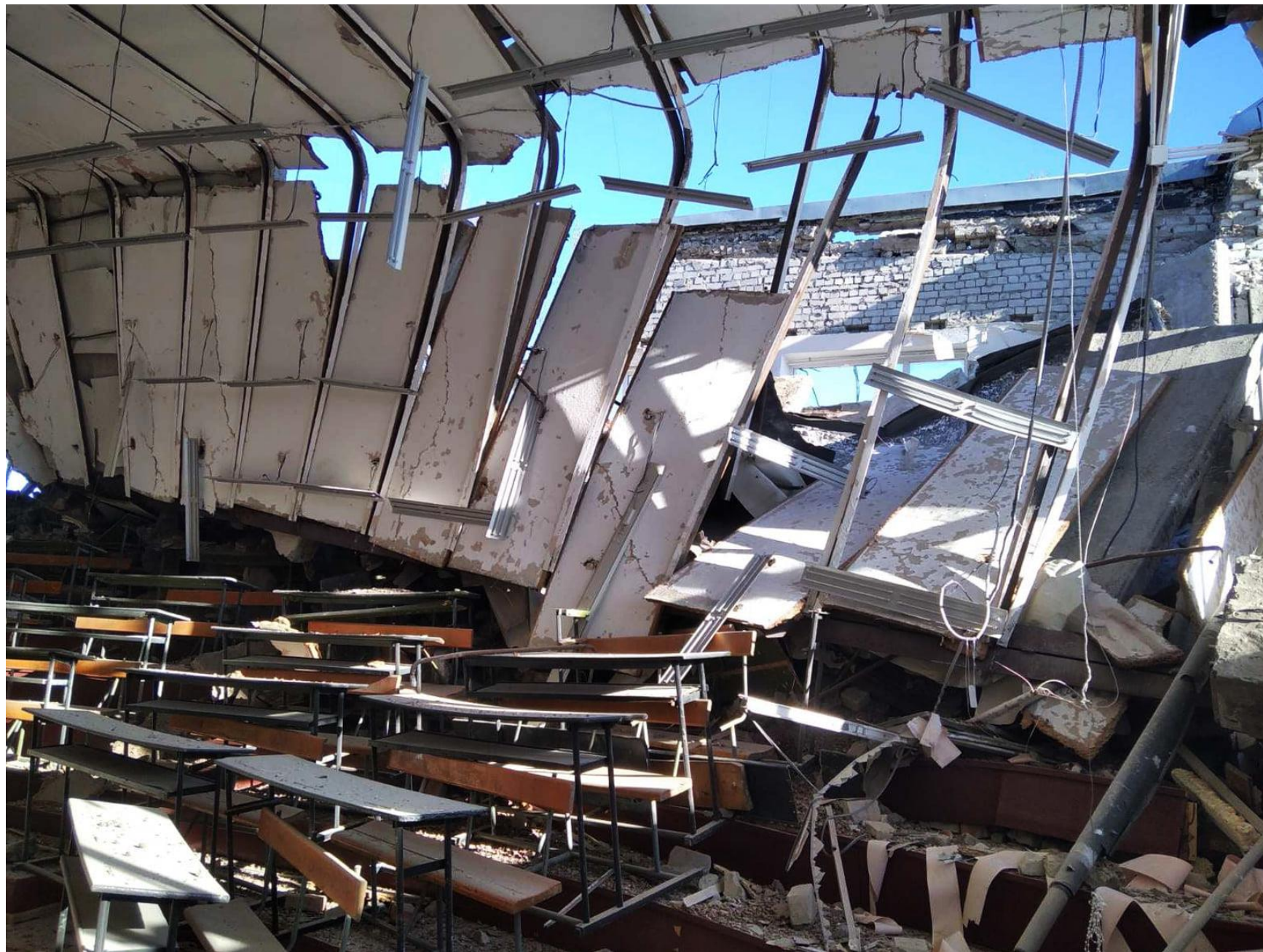


We will work closely with the U.S. NAS and the NAS of Ukraine to assess how to further support Ukrainian academic community

# War is a threat to all **17 SDGs**



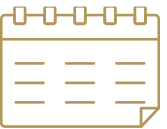
We need pro-active governmental and strong non-governmental institutions to support the post-war reconstruction of Ukraine
