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# Summary

## TAKE-HOME POINTS

- Transitional age group with heterogeneity in cognitive capacity for reporting
- Challenges with unobserved intake, forgotten foods, portion size determination, social desirability bias
- Choice of tool and analytic approach depends on research question, burden, level of accuracy desired, disadvantages willing to tolerate, and resources available
- Multiple methods of assessment can be valuable, and research needed to assess whether accuracy and burden varies across populations and for emerging technologies
- Error and bias affect quality of dietary data collected and are important considerations when thinking about best practices
