

Affected areas and water districts *Rural areas have NOT been given equity of "non detect" for our drinking water by DoD



Forgotten Families

Military Families move every 3 - 4 years

* We need access to health studies, and military members need VA assistance (like Agent Orange)

Rural Families

* Surrounding areas with PFHxS levels under the advisory are NOT receiving clean and safe drinking water at the non-detect level the four municipalities are being provided for

Environmental Justice

*Finally getting legislative bills passed in CO to have oversight committees
*Our community is intentionally targeted due to the high turnover rate of military families moving
*We have a larger population of Black, Brown, and Indigenous families
*Our coalition has participated in passing 6 legislative bills since 2019 to protect ourselves

Access to Healthcare and Specialized Medicine

* There are NO hospitals in the Southern half of our county

*There have been 2 other major contaminations that led to litigation

*An additional 4 minor environmental disasters have also occurred in these communities


We don't have hospitals here
