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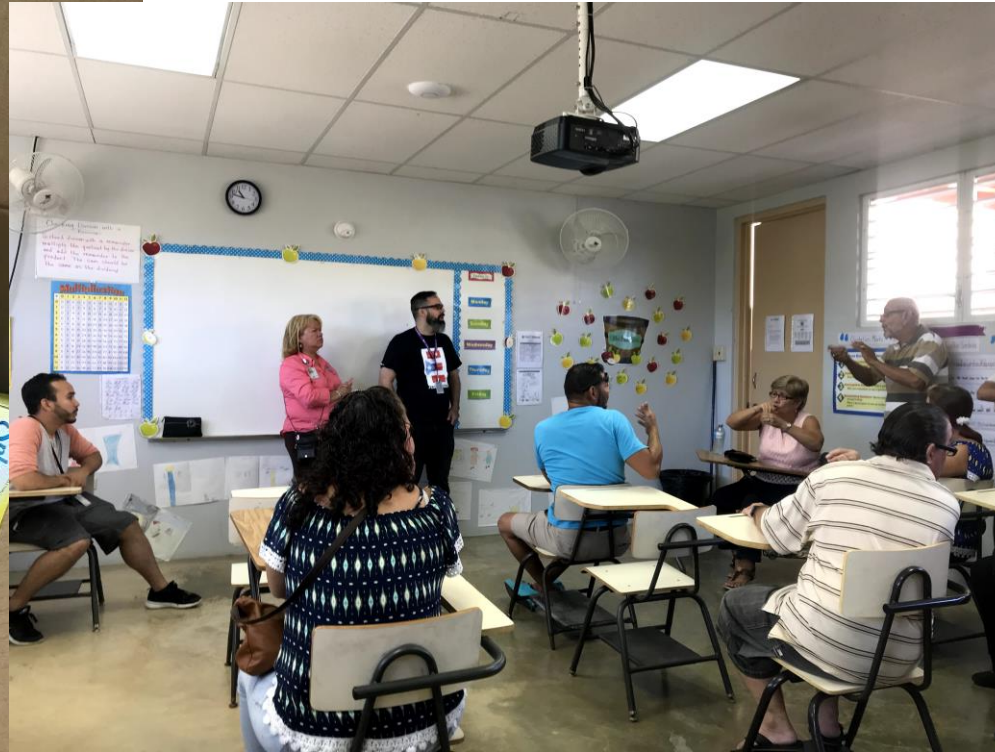

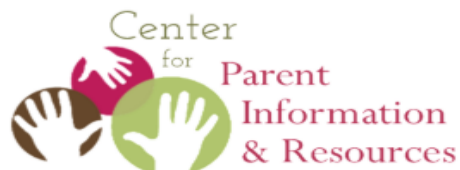

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The nation has had many natural disasters of late, all of which have caused catastrophic damage and been traumatic to those impacted. There are also sections on resources to help people respond **during** the event itself; materials and help for the aftermath focused on **support and recovery**; and tips for parents, caregivers, and mental health professionals as to how to provide support following a specific kind of disaster. 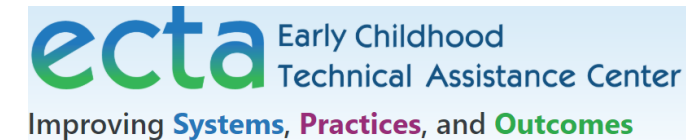
