## **DHC School District Data**

- Differential privacy eliminates 77% of 2010 school district content from the DHC
- School district data losses are inconsistent with Census 2020 messaging about:
  - The importance of census data to support schools
  - The ability of differential privacy to preserve 2010 content
  - The commitment to inform data users about the impact of privacy methods
- Unexpected privacy-related outcomes in 2020 raise doubts about Census communications for ACS and 2030



The 2020 Detailed DHC provides table content for more than 1,400 census tracts that intersect the Los Angeles Unified School District.

The 2020 DDHC does *not* provide table content for LAUSD (despite a population of 4.6 million people) because school districts are not a DDHC publication geography.
