

 - Spans industries including professional services (e.g., marketing, HR, legal, financial), education, and e-commerce, but the vast majority are in software








- Growing support within startup ecosystem





Jerry Davis What Might Replace the Modern Corporation? Figure 1: American corporations listed on U.S.




