




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What knowledge and human capital gaps do we need to fill to produce research that is useful and used?




What research is useful and used?

Training


 Research use for educators in preparation and practice

Demand

Knowledge

- Measures of research use
- Conditions and strategies that increase research use







Supply

Process

- Increase the voice of practice
- Reduce barriers for short-term projects
- Require stronger evidence of partnership

Knowledge

- Answer questions of practice
- Build local knowledge through RPPs

Training
