# Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)

#### **March 2020**

Recommends that facemasks are an acceptable alternative when the supply chain of respirators cannot meet the demand.

#### **April 2020**

<u>Considering guidance</u> advising healthcare workers, fire fighters and EMS personnel to don surgical masks in their workplaces at all times.

#### **March 2020**

Our position is and will remain that the N-95 or higher respirators afford the best protection for our workforce when it comes to caring for suspected and confirmed COVID-19 patients.

<u>Strongly Recommends</u> all IAFF members wear a surgical masks in their workplaces at all times.


