

Each year, opioid overdose, misuse, and dependence account for:



\$35 billion in health care costs1

Patients who experienced an opioid overdose accounted for \$1.94 billion in annual hospital costs.<sup>2</sup>



\$14.8 billion in criminal justice costs<sup>3</sup>

Each dollar invested in addiction treatment reduces drug-related crime, theft, and criminal justice costs by \$4-\$7.4



\$92 billion in lost productivity<sup>5</sup>

The losses stem from premature death due to overdose, "productive hours" lost to OUD, and opioid-related incarceration.

#### **ABOUT THAT \$26 BILLION SETTLEMENT**

On July 21, 2021, a \$26 billion offer to settle was made by opioid manufacturer Johnson & Johnson (\$5 billion) and the "big three" distributors McKesson, AmerisourceBergen, and Cardinal Health (\$21 billion) to resolve their liabilities in over 3,000 opioid crisis-related suits nationwide.



# CVS, Walgreens and Walmart Must Pay \$650.5 Million in Ohio Opioids Case

A federal judge ordered the big pharmacy chains to bear partial responsibility for the deadly drug crisis.



#### A State-by-State Look at the 1998 Tobacco Settlement 23 Years Later

Despite receiving \$27 billion from the tobacco settlement and tobacco taxes, the states continue to severely underfund tobacco prevention and cessation programs proven to save lives and money. In the midst of a youth e-cigarette epidemic, such programs are as critical as ever.





# ZERO

The number of states that fund their tobacco prevention and cessation programs at CDC-recommended levels. Only 10 states meet half the recommended amount.





#### Most at risk to smoke populations:

- Lower income
- Less educated
- Midwest and South
- American Indians/Alaska Natives
- LGBTQ
- Uninsured or enrolled in Medicaid
- People with mental illness
- "Black Americans die at higher rates from smoking-caused diseases, in large part due to the tobacco industry's predatory targeting of Black communities with menthol cigarettes"
