

Advocate Children's Overview



- Ability to Serve 2.2M+ Children in the combined geography
- Multiple Children's Hospital Campuses with Pediatric Beds
 - Hyde Park: 165 (Partner U of C/Comer Children's)
 - Oak Lawn: 151Park Ridge: 129
- 10 Additional Advocate, NorthShore & UCM Hospitals with Pediatric Beds
- 6 Level III NICUs, 1 Cardiac ICU, 3 PICUs
- 3 Pediatric Emergency Departments
- 165,000+ Pediatric Emergency and Urgent Care Visits
- Network of 550+ Employed Primary Care/Specialist/MFM Physicians
- 350+ Pediatric ambulatory / physician access points in the market














Pediatric Subspecialty Footprint



- Ambulatory Strategy focused on multi-specialty pediatric ambulatory hubs to provide local access to care
- Continue to expand into Western Suburbs
- 241 Medical and Surgical Subspecialists
- 198,549 total subspecialty visits in 2021 (growth of >40K in 3 years)











ACH-PR Pediatric Residency Program

- Medium-sized residency program located in Park Ridge, Illinois
 - 42 Residents (14/year)
 - 27 DOs, 14 US MDs, 6 IMG MDs
 - 33 different medical schools
- 3 Academic Affiliations
 - Rosalind Franklin University
 - University of Illinois at Chicago
 - Chicago College of Osteopathic Medicine













Community Exposure

- School Based Health Center
 - Comprehensive medical and mental health services
 - Home to students from over 50 different cultural backgrounds speaking over 75 different languages
 - Longitudinal experience monthly during PGY2 year
- ACH Ronald McDonald Care Mobile
 - 3-4 scheduled days with mobile health team each resident each year of training
 - Patients without insurance or without access to care
 - Physicals, immunizations and referrals
- Community General Pediatric and Subspecialty Clinic Experience














X+Y Scheduling




Overview

- National pilot project through ACGME AIRE to provide focused time on each portion of residency training
- Outpatient continuity clinic and longitudinal rotations scheduled apart from X block rotations
- Decrease interruptions in both inpatient ward rotations AND subspecialty electives and individualized curricula
- ACH-PR Subspecialty Academic Half Day (10-11 residents with 1 Peds Subspecialist)











Post-Residency Career Paths

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- Strong mentoring program
 - Resident paired with general or subspecialty faculty for advising beginning prior to start of residency
 - Formal fellowship advising program
 - Very engaged pediatric subspecialty faculty mentors
- Variety of career paths
 - 32% Outpatient Primary Care
 - 15% Pediatric Hospital Medicine
 - 53% Pediatric Subspecialty
 - PICU(7), NICU(6), Hem/Onc(5), DBP(4), GI(3), ID(3), Pulm(2), Endo(2), Sports, Sleep, Palliative, Adolescent,
 Nephro, A/I
