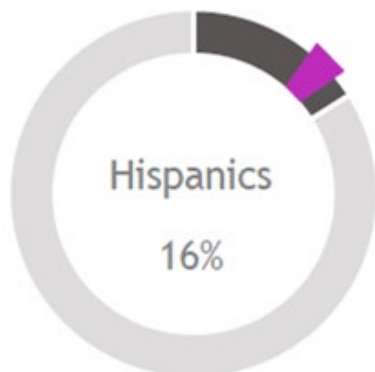
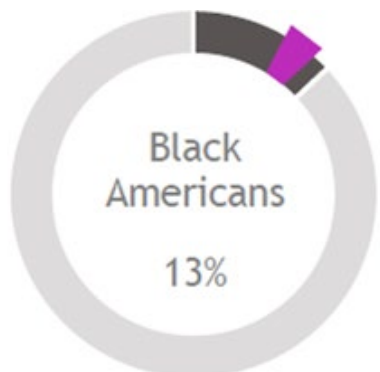


The Robert A. Winn Diversity in Clinical Trials Award Program

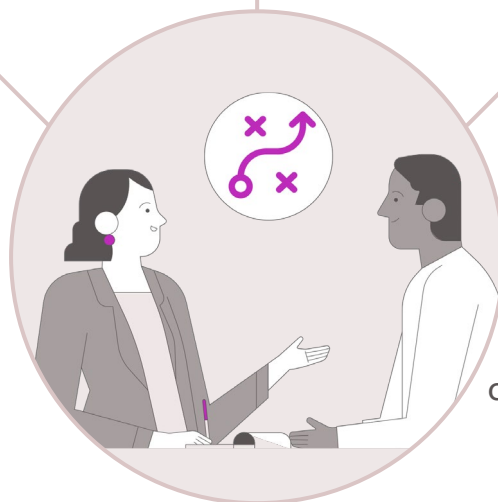

Design inclusivity from the start



Train

308 new clinical investigators with community engagement and research skills through the 2-year *Career Development Award (Winn CDA)*



Engage

308 URM medical students in clinical research through a 6-week *Clinical Investigator Pathway Program (Winn CIPP Award)*









Support

Available to program graduates to support ongoing career and leadership development in clinical research

- Bristol Myers Squibb Foundation (BMSF)¹ = \$100MM funding 5 Cohorts (250 scholars & 250 students)
- Gilead Sciences, Inc. (Gilead) = \$14MM funding 4 Cohorts (40 scholars & 40 students)
- Amgen = \$8MM funding 3 Cohorts (18 scholars & 18 students)

Purpose:

To train **a new generation of world class clinical trialists** who possess the additional knowledge and competencies to foster active community engagement in clinical and translational research.

Components:

- Design and Implementation of Clinical Trials Workshop (4^{1/2} days)
- COCT Curriculum (2-yr)
 - Scholars Forum
 - Community Engagement Activities
 - Capstone Project
 - Annual Convenings
 - Individual Professional Development Plans (IPDP)
 - Mentoring
