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## Deconstructing the Complexities of Advance Care Planning Outcomes: What Do We Know and Where Do We Go? A Scoping Review

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#### Scoping Review Methods:

- ACP RCT's
- Jan 2010 to March 2020
- 1,464 identified 69 met eligibility
  - 70% published in/after 2017
  - 94% rated as high quality
  - None had been included in prior systematic reviews

#### Heterogeneity Among the Studies

- Definitions
- Populations
- Life trajectory
- Settings
- Intervention modalities
- Follow-up time points
- Outcomes (170 outcomes; 79 primary)

#### What patients want

- Person-Centered Care<sup>1</sup>
- To talk about ACP while they can still engage in decisionmaking<sup>2,3</sup>
- Paţients desire a way to:
  - prepare their families and surrogate decision makers
  - decrease their loved ones' decision-making burden<sup>4,5</sup>
  - to ensure their own wishes are honored<sup>6,7</sup>

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#### Evidence that ACP improves

	Process	(Readiness)	72%
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- Action (Communication) 86%
- Quality of Care
  - Congruence pt/surrogate/clinician 88%
  - Sat. with Communication 100%
  - Surrogate Sat. with Decision Making 67%
  - Surrogate Sat. with Medical Care 75%
- Health Status
  - Decreased surrogate anxiety/depression,
     PTSD, complicated grief
     100%
- What about goal concordant care?

#### Diversity and Disparities

- Explore, explain and work to eliminate health disparities
- Preparing for (and sharing) decision-making role as a path toward increasing trustworthiness of healthcare
  - Longitudinal congruence of treatment preferences in adult HIV+ population (86% AA; 39% incomes <FPL; 42% < HS education)<sup>8</sup>
  - 98% ACP engagement in diverse English- and Spanishspeaking Older Adults9
  - 41% more active patient participation in ACP during clinical visits (30.5% limited health literacy; 25% Spanish speaking)<sup>10</sup>
