Home visits now: 50 % of primary care visits










CARIÑOS Approach



<u>C</u>omprehensive, coordinated, compassionate care across various clinical settings that meets the older adults' needs beyond the office walls.

<u>A</u>dvocating for patients and families by collaborating and maintaining relationships with other clinicians and health care partners.

<u>R</u>especting what matters most to your older patients (e.g., meals, mobility, money, and medicines).

Intentional activities and processes in your practice that are specific to meet the needs of older adults.

<u>N</u>urtured relationships with families, social service agencies, and community partners.



CARIÑOS En Su Casa

is in-home comprehensive, coordinated, compassionate care that uses promotores, trained community health workers, to assist in breaking through common barriers such as lack of internet

and access to electronic media - i-pads or laptop computers



Home Visits

March 2020- set up as a way to reach our patients in CCRC

April – July – Slowly developed process

August – some face to face more at home using promotores

September 2020 – 50% Home 50% office or telehealth

March 2021-Set up department in EMR to create schedule

Reasons for success

Leadership support Team work – IT, EMR, Billing and Coding, Clinical Operations Training – staff and clinicians, patient and family/caregivers

IT troubleshooting – "virtual redcoats" Intentional processes and follow up eg visit types Pre-visit preparation Daily and weekly huddles



CARIÑOSApproach & CARIÑOS En Su Casa

No one size fits all, you have to identify what is your "size" depends on your patient population

Small achievable goals - one step at a time
