



G7

2015 - G7 produced a Best Practice Brochure and called for the High Level Meeting

- 2016 Discussed the International Review on AMR
- 2017 Developed One Health Definitions

### G20


- 2016 G20 Agricultural Ministers committed to phase out medically important antibiotics for growth promotion. Health Ministers issued call to action on economic incentives
- 2017 Global Collaboration Hub on AMR Research and Development
- 2018 Held an AMR table top
- 2019 Welcomed the IACG
- 2020 Health Working Group session on incentives



Goal 5: Improve International Collaboration and Capacities for Antibiotic-resistance Prevention, Surveillance, Control, and Antibiotic Research and Prevention

- 1. Enhance U.S. leadership in the global fight against antibiotic resistance.
- 2. Promote increased awareness and capacity in countries to address the emergence and slow the spread of antibiotic resistance.
- 3. Generate consistent and actionable global data on antibiotic resistance, including by extending CDC's AR Lab Network to global sites to address the identification, emergence, spread, and effects of antibiotic resistance.
- Increase international collaborations to facilitate basic, translational, and clinical research into understanding the causes of antibiotic resistance and developing countermeasures.
