## Cross-Cutting Points and Questions

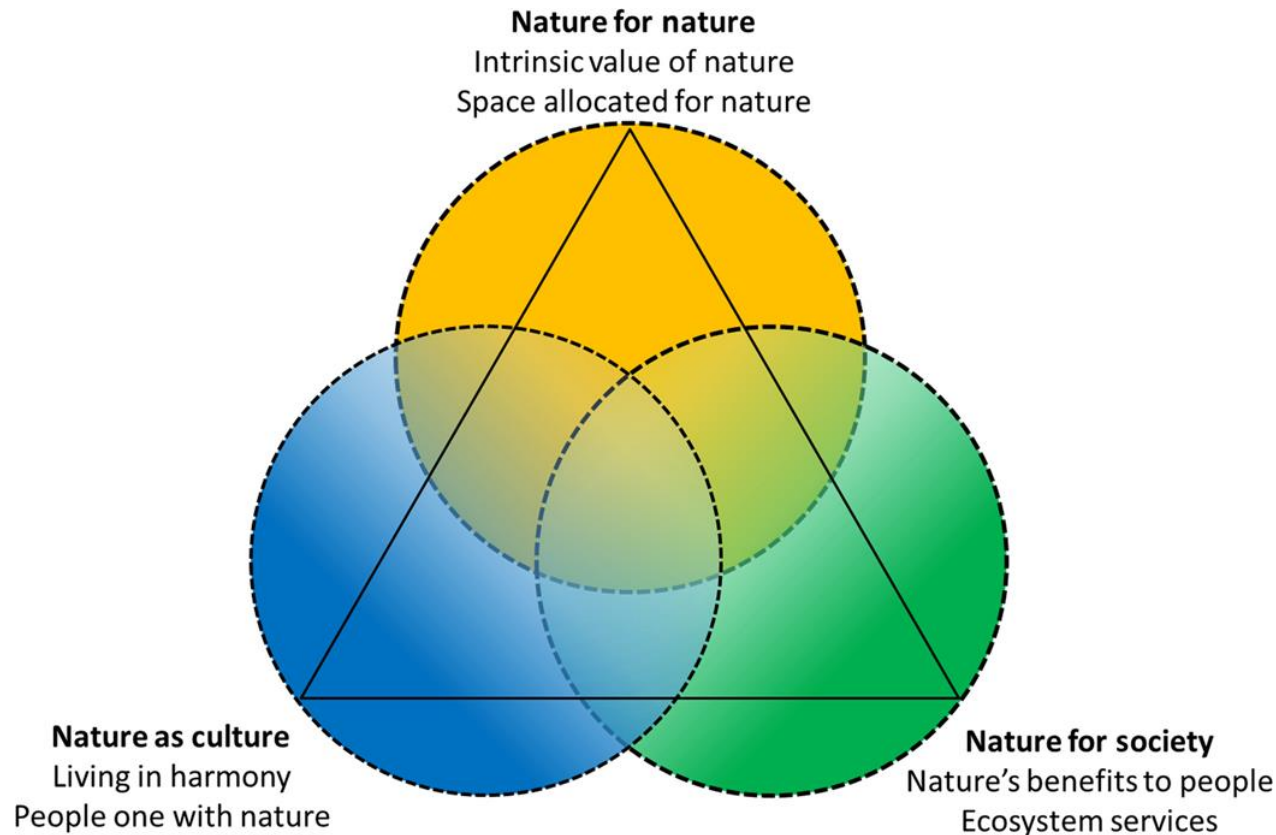
Technology plays a role in scenarios of sustainable futures. Despite progress in green technology, there are barriers to uptake.
