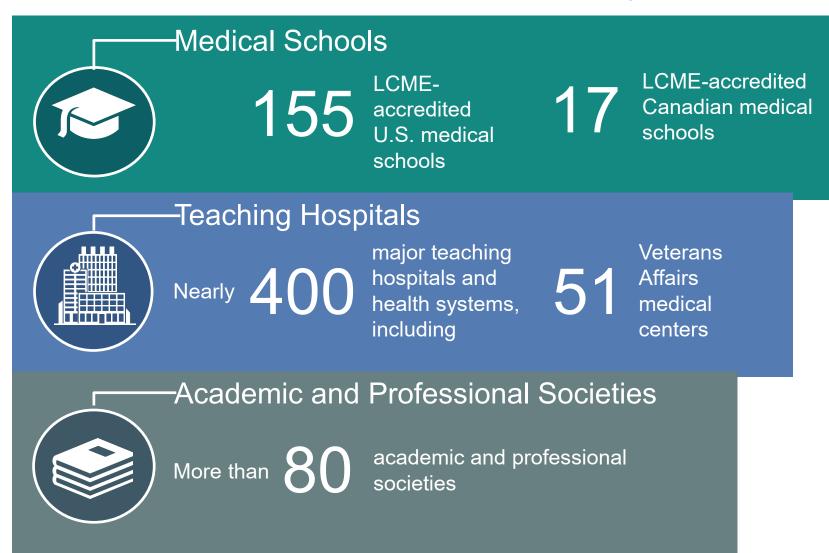

### **Curricular Management: WHO?**



(LCME\* 8.1) "A medical school has in place an institutional body (i.e., a faculty committee) that oversees the medical education program as a whole..."

#### **Curricular Content: WHAT?**

(LCME\* 6) "The faculty of a medical school **define the competencies** to be achieved by its medical students through medical education program objectives and is responsible for the detailed design and implementation of the components of a medical curriculum..."

(LCME\* 7) "The faculty of a medical school ensure that the medical curriculum provides **content of sufficient breadth and depth** to prepare medical students for entry into any residency program and for the subsequent contemporary practice of medicine."

"The medical curriculum includes content regarding the recognition of the impact of disparities in health care on all populations and potential methods to eliminate health care disparities."

Competency-Based Education



#### **Competency Based Education**

An outcomes-based approach to the design, implementation, assessment and evaluation of an educational program, using an organizing framework of competencies

- A way of thinking about, designing and facilitating education
- No single meaning or approach, but many common characteristics
- Shared competencies or outcomes provide teachers and learners with a common language

Determine whether your programs or offerings address these competencies in formal and informal ways and how methods used in one program, clerkship, or service may be used across settings.

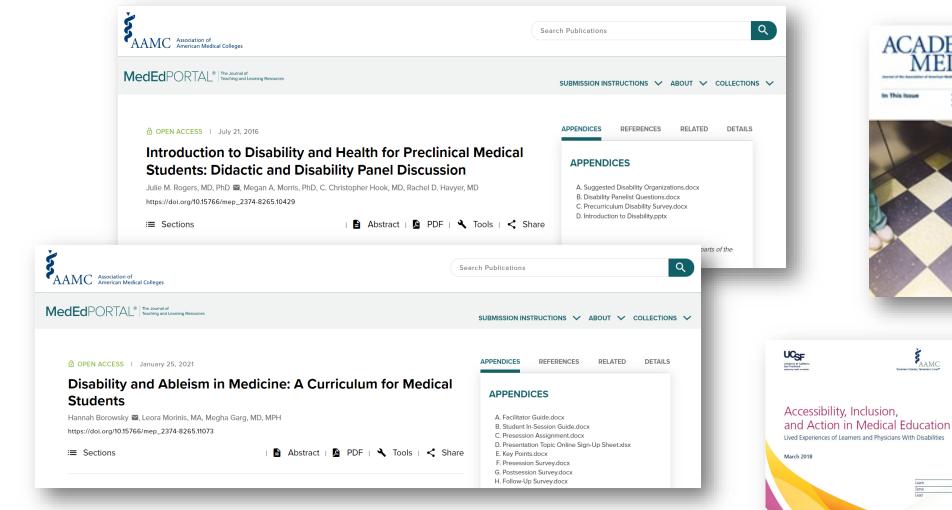
Prioritize for local needs and develop strategies to teach and assess these competencies and fill identified gaps.
