80 year-old woman with dementia presents for altered mental status. She comes in alone from her nursing home and is unable to provide any history.

Physical exam

Stable vital signs, oriented x 1 Exam difficult due to poor patient cooperation

<u>Laboratory findings</u> WBC 10,000 (80% PMNs)



+ LE, + WBC, occ bacteria, numerous squamous cells (culture pending)

- One common diagnostic error is: misdiagnosis of asymptomatic bacteriuria as a urinary tract infection

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"The majority of positive urine cultures from inpatients without an indwelling urinary catheter represent asymptomatic bacteriuria. If you strongly suspect that your patient has developed a urinary tract infection, please call the microbiology laboratory."

Rates of antibiotic treatment for asymptomatic bacteriuria fell from 48% to 12%
