

#### **GLS Grant Programs**

#### **GLS Campus**

- 3-year grant
- Available to higher education institutions
- Supports student suicide prevention activities.
- Requires matching funds
- \$102,000/year

### **GLS State/Tribal**

- 5-year grant
- Available to states and Tribes
- Supports suicide prevention activities, through a public health approach, for youth ages 10-24 years old
- \$735,000/year




#### **Suicide Prevention Grants Strategies and Activities**

- Prevention, intervention, and postvention strategies on statewide or tribal basis.
- Example strategies:
  - Providing screening and/or gatekeeper training
  - Improving care transitions and utilizing hotlines
  - Enhancing social connectedness
  - Engaging high-risk populations
  - Improving lethal means safety




#### **IMPACT BY TIME OF EXPOSURE**
