Roundtable topics of discussion include how AI can contribute to:

- optimizing energy systems and other climate-influencing infrastructures
- aiding effective, just, and equitable climate-related research and decision-making
- developing assessments, policies, regulations, and markets related to climate change.

The roundtable will also examine the energy consumption and climate effects of Al technologies and strategies for mitigating those impacts.
