

Manhattan Project Records

- Small Collection (36 cubic feet) at Los Alamos National Laboratory
 - May contain “lists” of military personnel
 - Health/Medical records incorporated with other personnel (alphabetical)
 - Hardcopy format/Electronic index
- Majority Transferred to the National Archives and Records Administration:
 - NARA Record Group 77: *Records of the Office of Chief of Engineers (General Groves records)*
 - NARA Record Group 80: *General Records of the Department of Navy***
 - NARA Record Group 326: *Atomic Energy Commission*
